





SLSTSE Ranking, Information and FAQs

SLSTSE Topper : A student of any class across the State, who achieves 100% marks is awarded a prize of ₹ 25,000. If no student achieves the same, then the student who achieves the highest percentage of marks among all the classes, is awarded ₹ 15,000. If more than one student achieve the same, the prize money is distributed equally among them. Each topper gets either this prize or the regular prize.

State Achievers : State Rankers 1 to 3 are declared State Achievers.

Distrcit-wise Achievers : 1st & 2nd Rankers District-wise, excluding the top 3 ranks across the State.

Class Topper : Class Topper of every class from every participating school.

Getting Certificate and SPR

Participation Certificate & Student's Performance Report (SPR) are sent to respective schools.

Information regarding relative performance, maximum marks scored by a topper in each class.

Why do students of the same class with similar total marks have different State Ranks?

When more than one student get an equal top score, priority for awarding ranks will be according to marks acquired in the following specified order of subjects: Mathematics, General Science/Physical Science, Biology and Critical Thinking.

What does "--" in the Rank column mean?

"--" indicates less than 30 percent of marks.
