#### Clarifications to select questions

Q.20 : Ans. : (B). Clarification : 'Insult' is not a synonym for 'disgrace'. Question no.20 relates to the 'noun form' as it does not have 'to' before the word 'disgrace'.

Q.25 : Ans. : (B) or (C).

Q.37 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : Answer cannot be (B), because the question says, 'how many types are described?' and not 'how many types are mentioned?'

Q.43 : Ans. : (D). Clarification : Answer cannot be (A), because the mention in the passage is that the fans will write e-mails or make calls to 'the personal assistant', whereas option (A) states that they will write fan mails to their 'idols' not to 'the personal assistant'. On comprehending *i.e.* on understanding the passage fully, it leads us to only option (D).
