#### Clarifications to select questions

Q.3 : Ans. : (A).

Clarification : 'B' is not correct. You 'learn swimming or anything' but 'take lessons' in swimming or anything.

Q.10 : Ans. : (C).

Clarification : 'How' is an 'adverb' and not a preposition. Here, we need to use a preposition 'as', which precedes the pronoun 'I', indicating 'the process of doing something', viz. the demonstration.

Q.17 : Ans. : (D).

Clarification : 'D' 'Will' is correct as it is seeking permission and making a request both than ability to take. 'Can' expresses only ability and to an extent possibility but does not necessarily seek permission and so does not fit in.

Q.25 : Ans. : (A).

Clarification : 'B' 'formal', can not be an antonym for 'traditional'. It is the antonym of 'informal'.
