#### Clarifications to select questions

Q.1 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : The present continuous tense is used to express a future action, especially when it is pre-determined. Will+infinitive implies intention alone, and this intention is usually, though not necessarily, unpremeditated.

Q.6 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'A' is correct. Remember we are asked to fill the blanks with modal verbs, expressing possibility.

Q.8 : Ans. : (D). Clarification : The mention of 'last day' compels us to use 'must'.

Q.11 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : 'C' is the suitable option. What you need is a 'clean' one. If you are asking for something cleaner *i.e.* less dirtier than what you already have, it still may not be 'clean' totally. 'C' also supports comparative parallelism, as an antonym to 'dirty'.

Q.15 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : Occasions are auspicious. Events/happenings are important/interesting.

Q.16 : Ans. : (B). Clarification : Your ability to lift is judged by the strength you have. Your 'capacity' is decided by the strength you possess. Stamina is related to persistence and/or the length of the period over/for which your capacity is utilised.
