Clarifications to select questions

Q.1 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : 'Yesterday', a past action. Verb must be in past tense 'went'.

Q.2 : Ans. : (D). Clarification : Natural phenomena – Present Tense – boils.

Q.3 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'A' is the correct option. The present continuous tense is used to express a future action, especially when it is pre-determined. Will+infinitive implies intention alone, and this intention is usually, though not necessarily, unpremeditated.

Q.4 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : Present perfect tense.

Q.5 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : Point of time – present perfect continuous tense.

Q.14 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : both ____ and ____ correlative conjunctions.

Q.16 : Ans. : (B). Clarification : glowing account – collocation.

Q.17 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : Neither = none of the two — always singular — is.

Q.18 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'a pair' singular — was.

Q.19 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : A reflexive pronoun — themselves.

Q.20 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : Question word used for things or place is 'which'.

Q.22 : Ans. : (D). Clarification : 'D' is the correct answer. 'The' is correct as article 'the' is used before a noun, which by reason of locality can represent only one particular thing or before a singular noun that represents a class of things.

Q.30 : Ans. : (D). Clarification : The sentence contains intransitive verb — there is no object — so passive can't be written.

Q.32 : Ans. : (A). Clarification : 'B' cannot be the correct answer as we are talking about 'transformation' of a sentence and not 'reporting' by another person.

Q.33 : Ans. : (C). Clarification : The sentence is a Natural truth — hence Indirect speech verb doesn't change.
