



Ranking System

ALL INDIA Achievers 1 to 25 Ranks:

Those who got ALL INDIA RANK 1-25 are declared as ALL INIDA achievers.

ZONE WISE Achievers 1 to 10

Zone wise Toppers are declared after excluding the top 25 ranks across the country.

Why do students of the same class with similar total marks have different National Ranks?

When more than one student gets an equal top score, priority for awarding will be according to marks acquired in the following specified order of subjects: Mental ability, Reasoning, Computers and English.

I got All India Rank 24. I want to ask that why I have not been shown in Zone wise achievers list?

Yours is an All India rank (AIR). Your rank is based on All India Level participation and Zone rank is only based on particular zone.

Note: Zone-wise achievers are declared excluding top 25 all India ranks.

What does "--" in Rank column mean?

Marks less than 30 percent, are shown as "--".

Class Toppers

A student is considered a class topper only if the class has a minimum of 5 participants. The 2nd and 3rd rankings will be awarded only if the number of participants in a class is more than 10 and 15 respectively. Overall, 10% of participants from every class are declared as Class Rankers. Class Rankers (acquiring marks 40% and above) are awarded a Medal and a Certificate of Appreciation, each.
