Match the following plants to their features by drawing a line across.

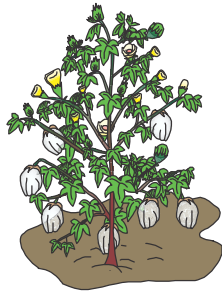
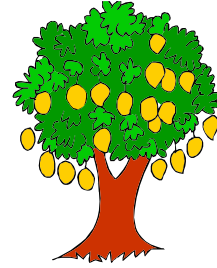
The illustration shows five plants in square boxes on the left and five text boxes on the right. Lines connect them as follows:

I am a weak plant. I cannot stand straight on my own. I need somebody's support. Am I a climber or a tree ?

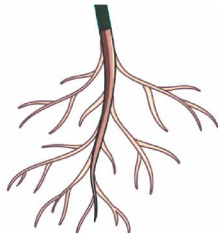

Plants need water to grow

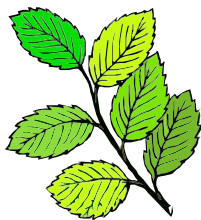


**ROOTS**

Make food for the plant

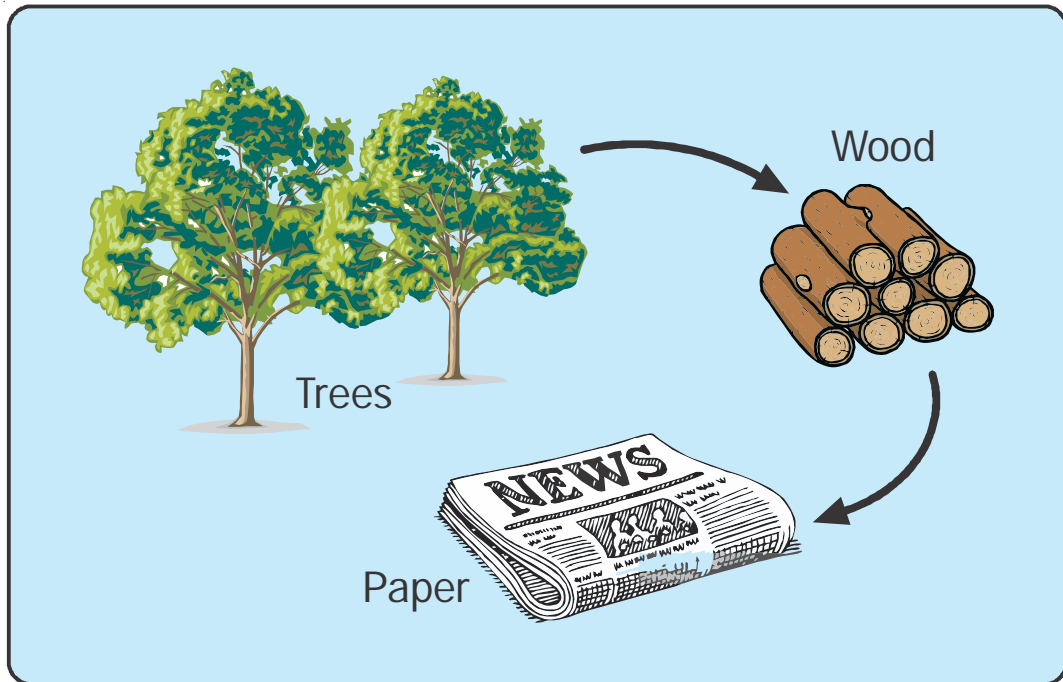
**FLOWERS**

Produce fruits and seeds

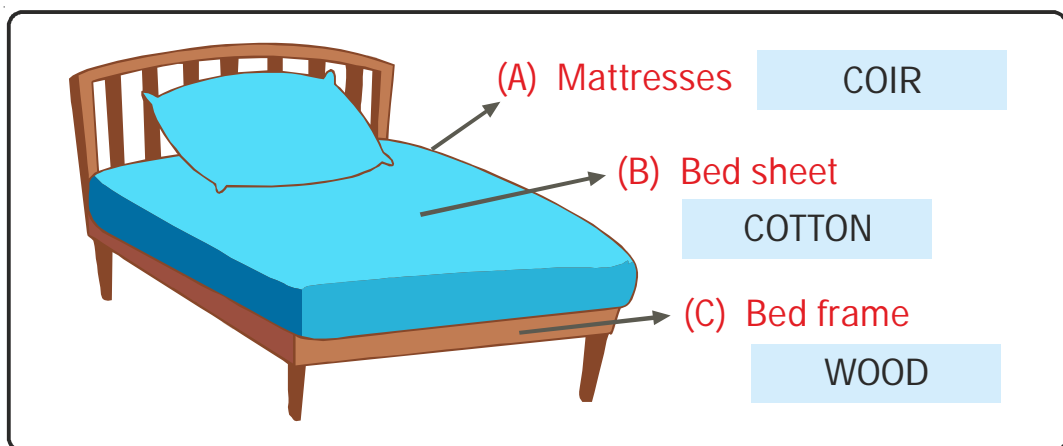
