We know that in addition order does not matter. Answer remain same even if we change the order.

03. (C) 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 are numbers in board

1 + 2 = 3	2 + 3 = 5	3 + 4 = 7	4 + 5 = 9
1 + 3 = 4	2 + 4 = 6	3 + 5 = 8	
1 + 4 = 5	2 + 5 = 7		
1 + 5 = 6			

Now list all different result 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9

There are 7 possible different result.

04. (B) The total number of flowers = 6

Out of those, 4 flowers have 5 petals each :

$$5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = 20 \text{ petals}$$

The rest of the flowers: $6 - 4 = 2$ flowers

These 2 flowers have 3 petals each: $3 + 3 = 6$ petals

Now add them together :

20 (from 5-petal flowers) + 6 (from 3-petal flowers) = 26 petals

So, the total number of petals is 26

Arun has more than 10, but less than 15
So Arun could have 11, 12, 13 or 14 marbles.

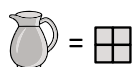

Total = ₹45 + ₹70 + ₹50 = ₹165

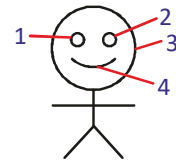

So the remaining ribbon (not red or blue) must be the purple ribbon, which is 7 cm long.

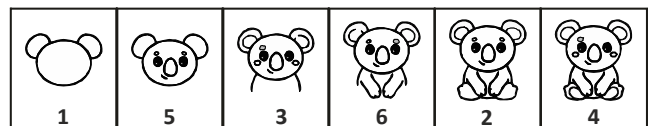

After 36 : $36 + 6 = 42$
Missing numbers are 6 and 42
Now, calculate their difference :
 $42 - 6 = 36$

 It cannot go online, cannot run apps, and cannot download anything.

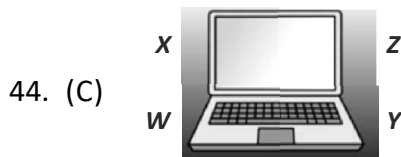
So, Ria cannot use the calculator to download or play the game.

 This can happen if the battery runs out or the power cable is unplugged.

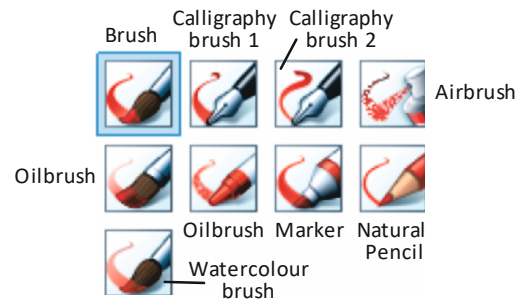
The game would stop immediately in this case.
