- 23. Errors/corrections appear in brackets : He said he didn't knew (know) what's (what was and not is or has as 's suggests) wrong with there (their) aunt. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 31. It is an advice. If 'please' would have been included, it would have become a 'request', option 'D'. If exclamation mark (!) would have been included, it would have become a warning. So, option (A) is the correct answer.
