Explanations and answers to select questions

- 06. About omission of ['s], and keeping only the apostrophe (') sign, the rules are as follows:
 - 1. After all plural nouns ending in s, as in animals, houses, etc.
 - Whenever the last syllable of a singular noun (common or proper) begins and ends in s as in Moses, Jesus, etc. So, Moses' is correct and Moses's is not. But, James's is correct and James' is not. So, option (A) is the correct answer.
- 26. Option (C) is the correct answer, as it is a universal truth, it does not change tense in the indirect speech.
- 32. Option (D) is the correct answer. It is the only option where 'ch' is pronounced as 'k', unlike in other options.
- 33. Option (B) is the correct answer. Errors/corrections appear in brackets : An ant is a (an) insect but it's (its) sting is painfull (painful) even for (a) bull.
