Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (D) : 'Species' is the correct answer. It is the spelling for singular as well as for plural of that word.
- 05 A 'gerund' is the 'present participle of a verb' or the 'ing form of a verb'. 'Float', 'Note' and 'Vote', are all verbs, the gerunds of which appear respectively as options (B), (C), and (D). It is only 'Boat' that is not a verb and hence only option (A) 'Boating' can be the correct answer.
- 08 The masculine gender for 'governess' is 'tutor' and not 'governor'. Please refer to Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary or any good dictionary for that matter. So, option (C) is the only correct answer.
- 11 The question is 'Which option cannot be a past tense?' The question is not about 'adjectives', but is about 'past tenses'. And all options except option (D) can be past tenses. The past tense of 'tread' is not 'treaded', but is 'trod'. And so option 'D' is the only correct answer.
- 15 Option (C) : 'Swipe' is the correct answer. It is 'Sweep+wipe'.
- 16 Option 'B' : 'PQRS' is the correct answer. The corrections are shown in brackets : Lets ("Let's) not walk any further' (farther"), my older (elder) sister said too (to) me.
- 33 Option 'C' : 'Shield' is the correct answer. Gear is a synonym of Equipment, and so is Shield of Armour.
- 44 In case of landfilling, all factors except the fact that it is difficult to find locations for landfilling, is left out. The reasons why people don't want landfills near their residence and what harm landfills can reach people in addition to the possibility of usable materials going waste, are all considered. So, all (A), (B) and (C) are considered but then where do we find the land for a 'landfill' (D), is not considered while considering 'landfill' as a method for disposal. One needs to 'comprehend' the given story and not simply refer to things mentioned therein. 'Comprehension' includes, things 'not mentioned' too, as a result/outcome/effect of the things mentioned in the story. Option (D) indeed is the correct answer.
- 45 Option (A) : 'Two' is the correct answer. The two types are : 'organic' and 'inorganic'. Option (D) : 'Four' are the methods of managing garbage or waste disposal.
