Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (A) is the correct answer. Option (C) cannot be the answer. Remember, it should be an irreversible (binomial) word pair.
- 02 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is: Barbecue.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is: Ver-y.
- 07 Option (A) is the correct answer. Option (B) is not a past tense, it is an adjective, 'died' is.
- 09 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is a V_1 and is pronounced as, 'Entraance'.
- 10 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is Splurge = Splash+Surge.
- 21 Option (A) is the correct answer. The word 'tempest' is a noun which means 'a violent storm' and is not a superlative degree, hence the article 'a'.
- 22 Option (B) is the correct answer. With the main clause supplied, we need to fill only past perfect (had run), to complete that third conditional with its pattern: 'If + past perfect (had run), would + have + past participle (bought)'.
- 27 Option (B) is the correct answer. "Couldn't" is an action in a more recent past. The earlier past action is of 'locking', so a past perfect 'had locked' for that.
- 28 Option (C) is the correct answer. For keeping the structure of the sentence parallel, two gerund phrases need to be used.
- 29 Option (D) is the correct answer. The words in the first pair are synonyms of each other and so are 'Furnish' and 'Equip'.
- 33 Option (D) is the correct answer. When the reporting verb is in simple future tense (*will say* here) there is no change of tense in the reported speech.
