Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are : (i) Onion [S], (ii) Lotus [R], (iii) Clock [Q], (iv) Mango [P]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are: (i) Bat [R], (ii) Hut [S], (iii) Hat [P], (iv) Ant [Q]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 12 Option (C) is the correct answer. They are: Dark, grey and fast.
- 16 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Dog and Bone', is a binomial, 'Dog and Leash' is not.
- 20 Option (B) is the correct answer. We decide to use article 'a' or 'an' depending on the sound the first syllable of that word produces. In 'hour', the sound produced by the first syllable is that of a vowel as in 'our', so 'an' is used. And 'the', because a particular office, not just any.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. The other 3 are relatives.
- 26 Option (D) is the correct answer. The 'duty', 'to protect', as an elder brother; 'care' by 'not letting any harm reach her', by stopping her from eating pebbles and picking her up at the right time'; and 'love' by 'letting her enjoy the pleasure of tearing pages of a book', even though it meant damage to his possession.
