Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Grammar'.
- 05 Option (D) is the correct answer, because only that forms its past tense by adding 'ed' at its end.
- 10 Option (C) is the correct answer. The homophones of all other options are, won, too and ate, respectively.
- 12 Option (A) is the correct answer. The presence of 'but' helps us further. The same forbids the use of other options.
- 13 Option (B) : 'an' is the correct answer. We decide to use article 'a' or 'an' depending on the sound the first syllable of that word makes. In 'honest', the sound produced by the first syllable is that of a vowel as in 'all', so 'an' is used.
- 19 Option (B) is the correct answer. Three words : mean, amen and mane, can be made *additionally*, from 'name'.
- 22 Option (B) is the odd one. It is the only one that cannot fly.
