**Explanations and answers to select questions**

- 10 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Exhort'.
- 13 Option (C) is the correct answer. The four words are : Gain, Gait, Gnat and Gnaw.
- 16 Option (C) is the correct answer. Option (B) : "it's" does not express possession. Option (C) : "its" does. Option (B) : "it's" is a contraction for 'it is'.
- 19 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'finished' and 'continued', are the two past actions. So, the earlier past action should be expressed using 'past perfect'.
- 20 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'One of', 'many', so 'gentlemen'.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. Mom has 'told', not 'said'; so option (B) is ruled out.
- 22 Option (D) is the correct answer. There is no comparison with anyone expressed and so a comparative degree is not required, only the positive degree is enough.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. The mention 'these days', plural of 'this day', refers to the present time, so we use a verb that relates only to the present time.
- 26 Option (C) is the correct answer. In most expressions of quantity, the verb is determined by the noun/pronoun that follows 'of'. So, 'book' that follows 'of', 'is'.
- 30 Option (D) is the correct answer. Either 'Q' should be changed to "don't need" or 'to' should be removed from 'R'.
- 33 Option (B) is the correct answer. As quick as lightning and as quiet as a mouse.
