**Explanations and answers to select questions**

- 01 The words are : (i) Angel [S], (ii) Claws [R], (iii) Straw [Q], (iv) Saint [P]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Bread [S], (ii) Cake [R], (iii) Burger [Q], (iv) Lemon [P]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 12 Option (B) is the correct answer. They are : 'large' and 'burnt'.
- 14 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Low' is pronounced as 'Lo'.
- 16 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Knife and Fork', is a binomial.
- 17 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Mary and I', together form the subject, so the noun/ pronoun has to be of a nominative case, which only 'I' is.
- 21 Option (D) is the correct answer. No article is used before a proper noun of a person so 'no article' for the first blank. The sound produced by the first syllable of 'great', is that of a consonant as in 'grade', so 'a' is used.
- 23 Option (D) is the correct answer. The other 3 are not collective nouns.
- 26 Option (B) is the correct answer. That is the central theme around which the story is built. All other options are either secondary to, or a part of, that.
