## Explanations and answers to select questions

05 Option (C) is the correct answer. A library of books.
06 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is Flurry = Flutter+Hurry.
07 Option (C) is the correct answer. Its singular is 'Femur'.
11 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : Asterisk.
15 Option (B) is the correct answer. They are : Adam and Dram.
23 Option (C) is the correct answer. Here, 'handed down', means 'announced'.
24 Option (B) is the correct answer. The sound produced by the first syllable of a word decides the indefinite article it takes. In case of 'hairdresser' the sound produced is that of a consonant as in 'head', so article ' $a$ '; in case of 'heir' it is pronounced as 'air', so article 'an'.
25 Option (A) is the correct answer. The reciprocal pronoun 'one another' is used when the reference is among more than two persons and 'each other' when between two persons.
26 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is incorrect to use a superlative degree again, when 'the most' is already there.
27 Option $(\mathrm{C})$ is the correct answer. The sentence is a second conditional with its pattern : 'If + past simple (were), would + infinitive (listen)'.
30 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Obey' is an antonym of 'Defy' and so is 'Aggravate' of 'Placate'.
32 Option (B) is the correct answer. When the reporting verb is in the present tense (says here), there is no change in the tense of the reported speech, though prepositions and pronouns change as per the rules.
33 Option (C) is the correct answer. The statement is a universal truth and hence no change of tense.
