Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'Mine' is the only homonym. 'Our' and 'Their' are homophones, not homonyms.
- 02 Option (A) is the correct answer. It's and Who's are contractions, 'Her' is a possessive adjetive, not a pronoun.
- 08 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is, 'Twelfth'.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. Malware = Malicious+Software.
- 10. Option (D) is the correct answer. In 'Running water', the word 'running' is an adjective that talks about the word 'water': 'water that is running'; so it is not a compound noun. Whereas in 'walking stick' the word 'walking' is not an adjective to the word 'stick' and does not indicate the activity of the stick. It is not 'the stick that walks'. But, it is a stick used for walking or while walking, and so is a compound noun.
- 20. Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Put something out', also means 'to place something where it will be noticed and used'.
- 27 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is a third conditional with the position of clauses inverse.
- 31 Option (C) is the correct answer. The change of voice (to passive) is not possible.
- 33 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Theology' is the study of religion, and 'Phenology' is the study of climate.
