## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are: (i) Parrot [S], (ii) Pigeon [P], (iii) Penguin [Q], (iv) Peacock [R]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Jellyfish [Q], (ii) Lobster [S], (iii) Shark [P], (iv) Turtle [R]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 03 Option (C) is the correct answer. He is 'sad' because tears are coming out of his eyes.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. Because there is no article such as 'a' or 'an' given before the blank, the blank cannot be filled using a singular, so a plural, 'scales'.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Bear' is pronounced as 'Bare', so it doesn't rhyme with 'Fear'.
- 12 Option (D) is the correct answer. A 'school' of dolphins.
- 17 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Sheep' is the same spelling for its plural.
- 23 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the only bird that can fly, the others can't.
- 26 Option (B) is the correct answer. See last sentence.
- 27 Option (C) is the correct answer. The four uncountabe nouns used in the story are : air, sand, sweet-corn and ice-cream.
- 28 Option (D) is the correct answer. The seven people on the beach were: Lily, Sam, their parents, two boys flying kites, vendor of the stall for sweet corn.
