Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 The words are : (i) Peanuts [R], (ii) Walnut [S], (iii) Nuts [Q], (iv) Coconut [P]. So, option (C) is the correct answer.
- 02 The words are : (i) Sloth [R], (ii) Cheetah [S], (iii) Rabbit [P], (iv) Ostrich [Q]. So, option (D) is the correct answer.
- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is plural of the common noun 'pear'.
- 04 Option (D) is the correct answer. It's the same spelling for its past tense.
- 06 Option (C) is the correct answer. It has the same spelling for its plural.
- 07 Option (D) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'jewellery'.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. A 'deck' of cards.
- 13 Option (C) is the correct answer. 1. 'Music' is an uncountable noun so it does not take any indefinite article. 2. Neither it is any specific music, nor there has been a mention of it before, so 'the' isn't applicable.
- 17 Option (B) is the correct answer. 'Cattle' being a 'plural' can only take that verb.
- 18 Option (C) is the correct answer. The mention 'yelled' leads us to that.
- 21 Option (D) is the correct answer. The first pair is of fruits (things of the same kind). So the second should be also things of the same kind, and so they are (the ones that grow above the ground).
- 22 Option (C) is the odd one. It is the only one that is not man-made.
