## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 02 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its past tense.
- 06 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is an adjective meaning having too much flesh on body and weighing too much, and a noun meaning a white or yellow substance in the bodies of animals and humans, stored under the skin.
- 09 Option (C) is the correct answer. There is no verb as 'unend'.
- 12 Option (C) is the correct answer. The three adjectives are: his, brave and raging. Possesive adjectives in English (his) refer to the possessor and not to the thing possessed. 'Flash flood' is a compound noun.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. Option (B) cannot be because it is 'stripes' not 'strips'.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Yellow' is an uncountable noun here and so is 'red'.
- 23 Option (C) is the correct answer. The subsequent part of the sentence uses simple past. So, 'finishing of tea', which happened before that, needs to be expressed using 'earlier past', past perfect.
- 24 Option (B) is the correct answer. The sentence with <u>errors</u> and <u>(corrections)</u> is: The <u>pamplet</u> (pamphlet) should cuntain (contain) all relevant detail (details) see 'all'.
