Explanations and answers to select questions

- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is 'Coriander'.
- 04 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Paid' can be an adjective too.
- 06 Option (C) is the correct answer. The five syllables are: Ex-am-i-na-tion.
- 08 Option (C) is the correct answer. The 3 words that can be made are: detains, sainted and stained.
- 09 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Key'.
- 13 Option (D) is the correct answer. In 'vide', 'i' is pronounced as in 'ink' and not as in 'tie'.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. A bouquet of flowers.
- 17 Option (C) is the correct answer. For option (B) or (D) to be correct, the word before the blank should be "family's".
- 19 Option (C) is the correct answer, see the last word of the story.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. For option (D) to be correct, article before the blank should be 'an'.
- 22 Option (D) is the correct answer. The number . . . is.
- 24 Option (D) is the correct answer, see the mention 'every day'.
- 28 Option (D) is the correct answer. When the last syllable of a singular noun begins and ends with 's' as in "Moses" (Mo-ses), only an apostrophe is added after the last s of that noun, (Moses'). But if that is not the case, as in "Boss (Boss)", then we add apostrophe and s, both.
- 29 Option (B) is the correct answer. Article 'the' because a particular light, the one that will be useful for reading and 'a' because 'book' begins with a consonant sound and the reference is not to any particular book.
- 31 Option (D) is the correct answer. 'would' represents past tense of 'will' (he will), expressing 'possible intention/ event'. Option (B) 'should' expresses necessity, which isn't the case.
- 32 Option (C) is the correct answer. In addition to being an adjective like the others, it can also be a past tense, which the others can't be.
- 42 Option (C) is the correct answer. Option (B) and (D) will need a comma after 'carefully', to be correct.
- 44 Option (C) is the correct answer. The story mentions 'puppy', that doesn't specify its gender.
