Explanations and answers to select questions

- 04 Option (C) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Assassination'.
- 05 Option (D) is the correct answer. It's a noun and a verb, with different meanings.
- 06 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its plural.
- 08 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its past tense.
- 09 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is 'Sweep+Wipe'.
- 10 Option (D) is the correct answer. The 4 words are : Reins, Resin, Rinse and Risen.
- 14 Option (C) is the correct answer. The 3 adjectives are : unknown, her (*first mentioned*) and gold. Possessive adjectives in English refer to the possessor (her) and not to the thing possessed.
- 23 Option (D) is the correct answer. Starting with 'If', it is a 2nd conditional with its pattern : If + past simple (got), . . . would + infinitive (save).
- 26 Option (C) is the correct answer. The phrase 'as well as' seems to join the subjects, 'He' and 'wife', but it doesn't work as a conjunction and hence the verb agrees with the subject first mentioned, 'He'.
- 28 Option (C) is the correct answer. That's the correct order of adjectives to appear.
- 29 Option (D) is the correct answer. The first syllable of 'heir' produces a vowel sound as in 'air', so 'an'. The first syllables of 'european' and 'university' both produce a consonant sound as in 'you', so 'a'.
- 31 Option (D) is the correct answer. The reporting verb (*says*) being in present tense, there is no change of tense in the reported speech without quotes.
- 32 Option (C) is the correct answer. The verb 'forage' means 'to search for food' and the verb 'wildcat' means 'to look for oil'. So, 'forage' action is for 'food' and 'wildcat' action is for 'oil'.
- 33 Option (D) is the correct answer. To change the voice of a sentence in active voice, using future continuous tense (*as is of the given sentence here*), is not possible.
- 35 Option (B) is the correct answer. Only that is a homonym. It's the name of a bird and a fruit.
