## Explanations and answers to select questions

- 02 Option (D) is the correct answer, because it is pronounced as 'stake'.
- 05 Option (C) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Foaled'.
- 07 Option (C) is the correct answer. It has the same spelling for its plural.
- 11 Option (D) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is : 'Supersede'.
- 12 Option (B) is the correct answer. The three verbs are: 'fail', 'help' and 'dry'.
- 13 Option (D) is the correct answer. It is: Whimsy+Magical.
- 24 Option (C) is the correct answer. When 'Either' . . . 'or' is used, the subject closer to the verb determines the number of the verb. Here 'cousins' a plural, decides that, so, 'get'.
- 25 Option (B) is the correct answer. The single-syllabled word 'NRI', produces a vowel sound as in 'end', so 'an' for the first blank; and as the first syllables of 'european' and 'university' produce a consonant sound as in 'you', 'a' for the second and the third blank respectively.
- 28 Option (B) is the correct answer. The first pair is of synonyms, so 'jealousy', a synonym.
- 31 Option (D) is the correct answer. A future continuous cannot be changed to passive form.
- 32 Option (C) is the correct answer. Only that cannot be a verb too.
