Explanations and answers to select questions

- 05 Option (B) is the correct answer. The correct spelling is: Cemetery.
- 06 Option (C) is the correct answer. There is no verb as 'outgo'.
- 07 Option (D) is the correct answer. It's homophone is 'Maid'. Option (C): 'Thought' is not a homophone. It is a homonym.
- 10 Option (C) is the correct answer. The two adjectives are : 'unlikely' and 'running'. 'Fast' works as an adverb here
- 11 Option (B) is the correct answer. A 'flight' of birds.
- 12 Option (C) is the correct answer. The three syllables are: Fa-vour-ite.
- 15 Option (C) is the correct answer. 'Ferris wheel' is a 'ride' one takes. So, 'riding'.
- 20 Option (D) is the correct answer. See 'than' used in the sentence. So, you need to fill the blank using an adjective with a comparative degree.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. The girls are two in number, hence 'between'.
- 22 Option (D) is the correct answer. The first syllables of 'university' and 'one-way street' produce consonant sounds as in 'you' and 'won' respectively, so 'a', and because they are a specific type of people, 'the' before blind.
