Explanations and answers to select questions

- 01 Option (B) is the correct answer. The three words are : claimed, decimal, declaim.
- 03 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the same spelling for its singular.
- 04 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is pronounced as 'Cini'.
- 08 Option (C) is the correct answer. The five syllables are : 'hip-po-pot-a-mus'.
- 09 Option (D) is the correct answer. Its homophone is 'Damn'.
- 11 Option (C) is the correct answer. An army of ants.
- 14 Option (D) is the correct answer. The four adjectives are : cool, open, her and fast. Possessive adjectives in English refer to the possessor (her) and not to the thing possessed.
- 21 Option (C) is the correct answer. No article for 1st blank because of the presence of 'this' before the blank. The words 'egg' and 'cheese' used here are referred to as substance/material and thus are uncountable nouns. Hence they do not take any article.
- 31 Option (C) is the correct answer. Being a search engine like others, it is an exclamation too.
- 32 Option (D) is the correct answer. The word 'Deference' means the behaviour that shows that you respect somebody. Its relation to the word 'elder', can be correctly matched only with the relation of the word 'Stranger' with the word 'Indifference'.
- 35 Option (B) is the correct answer. The sentence with corrections in brackets is : I saw (watched) TV for 3 hrs (hrs.) yesterday (yesterday,) so can't (couldn't) do homework.
- 37 Option (D) is the correct answer. See the mention 'respectively' in the 2nd paragraph.
- 38 Option (C) is the correct answer. It is 'showcases'.
- 43 Option (B) is the correct answer. It is the plural of 'cactus'.
- 45 Option (D) is the correct answer. The four verbs are : Re-potting, outgrow, gives and spread.
